

Hot Water Boiler 100 Cup Operating Instructions

- 1. Confirm the switch is in the "OFF" position and the thermostat is set to 0 (zero).
- 2. Fill the urn at least half full with cool water to ensure it has the minimum level required to operate.
- 3. Place the lid on unit.
- 4. Plug the power cord into the appropriately rated outlet.

Ensure that the power supply you are using is adequate for continual usage and the voltage is correct

- 5. Turn the power switch to the "ON" position. The light will illuminate to indicate the power is connected.
- 6. Turn knob to the desired temperature.
- 7. When the indicator lights up, hot water is now ready to be served.
- 8. When the temperature cools down to about 10°C OR 50°F, the unit will restart and heat up automatically and the indicator will light up again.
- 9. When the temperature cools down to about 100°C or (212°F) , the unit will maintain a boiling temperature

CAUTION

- Do not touch any hot surfaces
- Do not immerse unit, cord or plug in liquid at any time
- Plug only into a 3-hole grounded electrical outlet
- Do not operate unattended
- Always operate on a firm, dry and level surface at least 12" from walls or any other obstruction
